Mollydooker Carnival of Love Shiraz (1.5L) 2005

Wine Advocate 98 points: "Deep garnet-brick colored, the 2005 Carnival of Love displays a more earthy, meaty, gamey character with plenty of coffee and damp loam aromas fused with smoked bacon, some iron ore, Chinese plums, a little floral note and even a bit of truffles character coming through. It is very rich and full-bodied, with the acid line standing out a little from the very concentrated and quite evolved fruit core. Still, it has amazing layers and a lot to give on the very long, licorice-laced finish, even if just a bit warm. Drink it to 2020+."



Mollydooker Enchanted Path Shiraz Cabernet Sauvignon (1.5L)

Wine Advocate 96 points: "It reveals an amazing opaque purple/blue/black color (always a hallmark of Marquis wines), a full-bodied, powerful, smoky nose, extravagant layers of fruit, spice, glycerin, and extract, full body, superb intensity, tremendous richness, and a seamless personality. It is a textbook example of a southern Australian red at its richest, fullest, and most pure. For consumers with open minds and progressive palates, this amazing red should age beautifully for 10-15 years."

Leeuwin Estate Le Prelude Chardonnay 2013

Delicate and restrained, the nose exhibits nashi pear, cut limes and white peach; interwoven layers of sesame, pecans, wheat biscuits and nougat, nurtures the primary fruits. Heightened floral notes of jasmine and lemon blossom lifts the nose giving fragrance, purity and subtle complexity. The palate is directed and focused; symmetry aligns around lemon, grapefruit and pear skin, through creamy oak, blanched almonds and sweet spice, leading to a finish that is hallmarked by bright natural acidity with incredible length and persistence.
