## Pierre Usseglio CDP Mon Aieul 2007 Rhone, France

Majority grape varieties: 705% Grenache , 10% Syrah



**Robert Parker 100 points:** "There are 1,800 cases of the 2007 Chateauneuf du Pape Cuvee du Mon Aieul (100% tank-aged Grenache). It represents an awesome naked/virginal expression of Grenache from three vineyard parcels planted in sand, clay, and limestone soils. After tasting this wine on five separate occasions, I can state with certainty, it has the most saturated color of any Mon Aieul produced to date. Moreover, **its perfume of blueberry liqueur, black raspberries, licorice, roasted meat juices, and lavender is incredible. Full-bodied power, a multilayered mouthfeel, tremendous purity, and awesome concentration put this wine in a class by itself. This sensational Chateauneuf du Pape is still very young, and 3-4 years of cellaring is required. It should be a modern day legend and last for nearly two decades.**

**Robert Parker 100 points:** "The 1946 Don PX Convento Seleccion produced with Pedro Ximenez grapes dehydrated under the sun at the time of the Second World War, was only **bottled in September 2011**. This is an extreme wine, my first descriptor was **ultra-mega-super concentrated**. It is **unbelievably powerful, both in the nose and the palate, full of umami, with sweet cinnamon, Christmas cake, camphor, petrol, lemongrass, Belgian chocolate and butter. Incredibly complex and rich, sweet, balanced and smooth in the palate, it is both very sweet and somehow salty, and with time it develops a black olive note. It combines the texture of the 1962 and the elegance of the 1949. It is as decadent as it gets. 825 bottles** were produced. This wine will survive all of us. These wines are kept for generations and offered in very small quantities, but it's amazing that you can still buy and drink something so old, and I'm even tempted to say that it might represent good value for what it is. A real tour de force sweet wine. Drink it if you ever have the privilege to do so from 2013-2060."



## Pegau Chateauneuf du Pape Cuvee da Capo 2003 **Rhone, France**



**Majority grape varieties: 70% Grenache**  
**The majority of the vines are 100 years old or older**

**Robert Parker 100 points:** *“For the fourth time, the Chateauneuf du Pape Cuvee da Capo has been produced, and for the fourth time, it has received a perfect score although I might back off the 2000’s perfect score based on the fact that it seems to be more of an upper-ninety point wine than pure perfection these days. The 2003 Chateauneuf du Pape Cuvee da Capo has distanced itself ever so slightly from the 2003 Cuvee Reservee. Before bottling and immediately after bottling, these two wines’ differences were not as evident. At present the Capo reveals that extra level of flavor, power, complexity and richness. It is a big wine (16.1% alcohol – less than in the 1998, but more than in the 2000 and 2007) boasting a dark plum/garnet color as well as a stunning bouquet of aged beef intermixed with pepper, herbes de Provence, and steak au poivre. This unctuously textured, full-bodied Chateauneuf possesses enormous body, huge flavors and sweet, velvety tannins. Still youthful, it has not yet begun to close down, and I’m not sure it ever will given this unusual vintage. It is a modern day classic that should continue to provide provocative as well as compelling drinking for 20-30+ years.”*

## Guigal Cote Rotie La Mouline 2003 **Rhone, France**



*(Grape variety: 89% Syrah, 11% Viognier)*

*Average age of vines: about 75 years*

*Ageing: 42 months in new oak*

**Eye:** Ruby red with red vermillion tints.

**Nose:** Small red fruits, blackberry and floral violet aromas. Intensely aromatic, powerful but full of finesse.

**Palate:** Supple with balance between the finesse of the aromas and an explosive richness due to the concentration of the wine. Greatly expressive of the terroir.

**Overall :** A feminine wine with voluptuous silky texture and intense aromas.

**Winemaking:** *Thermo-regulated stainless steel tanks. Traditional pumping over. Alcoholic fermentation or 4 week maceration.*

**Robert Parker 100 points:** *“It is drinking beautifully, yet is still young, loaded with fruit, and possesses over-the-top richness. Giving up notions of plum, liquid flowers, potpourri and smoked meats, this puppy is full-bodied, massive and layered on the palate, with a stacked mid-palate, thrilling amounts of texture, and a blockbuster-styled finish.”*

## Leoville Las Cases 1986 St Julien



**Robert Parker 100 points:** "The late Michel Delon always thought that this was the greatest vintage he had produced. We often tasted it side by side with the 1982, because I always preferred the latter vintage. Of course, the two vintages are quite different in style, with the 1986 a monument to classicism, with great tannin, extraordinary delineation, and a huge, full-bodied nose of sweet, ripe cassis fruit intermixed with vanilla, melon, fruitcake, and a multitude of spices. The wine has always been phenomenally concentrated, yet wonderfully fresh and vigorous. The wine still seems young, yet it is hard to believe it is not close to full maturity. It is a great example of Leoville Las Cases, and another compelling reason to take a serious look at the top Cabernet Sauvignon-based Medocs of 1986. Anticipated maturity: 2005-2035."

## **Donnafugata Ben Rye Passito di Pantelleria 2008**

**Sicily, Italy**

Retail: ~~\$780/btl~~

**Grapes:** Zibibbo (Muscat of Alexandria)

**Location:** South-western Sicily

**Altitude:** 20 to 400 m MSL

**Soils:** sandy, deep, extremely fertile soils

**Robert Parker 90 points:** "The 2008 Passito di Pantelleria Ben Rye flows with the essence of **burnt sugar, candied orange peel, dried figs and sweet spices**. There is a wonderful salinity that frames the fruit beautifully to the **long, creamy finish**. Ben Rye is **made from air-dried Zibibbo** grown on Pantelleria, an island located off the Western coast of Sicily. It is a **fairly rich, weighty dessert wine** that is probably best enjoyed on its **own**. **Anticipated** maturity: 2010-2018. "
