LE DOME 2006:

Robert Parker 94 points: “An opaque purple color is followed by notes of graphite, mulberries, blueberries and flowers. The 2008 is broad, savory and medium to full-bodied with sweet tannins, decent acidity, a textured, complex mouthfeel and no hard edges. It, too, should drink nicely for 10-15 years.”

LE DOME 2008:

Robert Parker 94 points: “The brilliant 2006 Le Dome (94) offers plenty of cassis and camphor as well as a terrific texture and that almost surreal lightness that comes from the high percentage of Cabernet Franc and what is obviously a top-flight vineyard. This elegant offering is not as dense as the 2008, but it is capable of lasting 15 or more years.”

Why Le Dome? (If you know this wine, this is an expensive brand)

- High Score, High quality wine, low yield (around 1,000 cases produced only)
- Produced by Chateau Teyssier in Saint Emilion
- Next to Angelus, close to Beausejour Becot and Canon
- Dominant proportion use of Cabernet Franc in the blend, the rest is old-vine Merlot
- While little exists, Le Dome is made with no expense spared in the pursuit of excellence

HAUT BERGEY 2005 (1.5L or 3L) Magnum or Double Magnum:

Robert Parker 92 points: "One of the finest under-the-radar estates in Pessac-Leognan, Haut-Bergey's 2005 (a blend of 65% Cabernet Sauvignon and 35% Merlot) offers up aromas of scorched earth, wet stones, burning embers, charcoal, and copious black currant and cherry fruit. The sumptuous bouquet is accompanied by a full-bodied wine displaying dazzling purity, sweet tannin, and a long, opulent finish. This beauty will be drinkable at a relatively early age for a 2005. Anticipated maturity: 2010-2025."

Wine Spectator 91 points: "Aromas of mineral, blackberry and licorice lead to a full body, with lots of racy tannins and a long, flavorful finish. There's plenty of character, with a polished, refined style, yet tannic. Best after 2011. 9,830 cases made."

In the 15th century the "Seigneur de la Louvière" and the "Seigneur d'Olivier" got to work on the reparcelling of agricultural land and so was born "La maison noble de Pontey" today named **CHATEAU HAUT-BERGEY**. This 28.5 hectares are located in the heart of the village of LEOGNAN, a leading area of Graves region. The subsoil is composed of clay and chalk streaked with iron-bearing parts that also contribute to the uniqueness and personality of the wines of HAUT-BERGEY.

This red wine is hand-made and great care is given to the selection afterwards, every parcel of vines is separately prepared in small vats of stainless steel or wood with integrated hot and cold regulation. It is aged in oak barrels for between 16 to 18 months according to the vintage.

All wines subject to final confirmation and on first come first serve basis. Stock is limited. Promotion offers last until **July 2, 2015**.
