His name is David Abreu. A rancher turned one of the most sought-after viticulturist in Napa Valley. He replanted **Screaming Eagle** in 2006. His grapes went into the bottlings of **Colgin Cellars' Cariad** every year. He is the Grape Guy behind a long list of well respected wineries in the valley, having farmed grapes for **Harlan, Blankiet, Sloan, Araujo, Bryant Family, Staglin, Family** and more. He is more than just a talented grape grower - together with a niche and specialised team, his namesake winery **Abreu Vineyards** has been making highly rated wines for 30 years.

Abreu Vineyards has cemented a solid reputation delivering superb wines, guaranteed by David Abreu's ability to crop supreme quality grapes from each of the single vineyards that he owned and managed. Winemaker Brad Grimes has since 2000 brought in his Chef's sensibilities into Abreu's miniscule production - just around 12,000 bottles a year - coaxing a sense of place and purity, on top of Napa's hallmark generosity and voluptuousness, into these single vineyard expressions.

Robert Parker 100-point reviews are no stranger to Abreu Vineyard's production. Loyal fans of Abreu Vineyards look up to these prized bottles as one of the very best wines made from the most meticulously managed grapes in Napa Valley. Abreu Cappella 2013

"The Cappella, which usually has at least 35-30% Cabernet Franc in it, looks absolutely fabulous now that the 2013 Cappella is finally in bottle. They only made about 206 cases of it, so it's a small cuvée from this vineyard on the back streets of St. Helena. It displays sweet espresso notes, loads of white chocolate, blackberry, Asian spice and incense. It is full-bodied and opulent, with the tannins surprisingly silky and well-disguised, which is somewhat unusual in this vintage of extraordinary power and density. This is a 35- to 50-year wine."

"The 2013 Madrona Ranch hits the magic three-digit score. It is literally a 30- to 45-year wine in itself. It behaves like a ripe, complex first growth Pauillac, with blackberry and crème de cassis, a touch of licorice, black truffle, pen ink and graphite. Incredibly fragrant, extremely full-bodied, with abundant tannin but also enormous fruit extract and richness, it is an amazing wine and a profound effort from Abreu and Grimes."

" This wine contains a considerable quantity of Cabernet Franc (probably 30% or more, although Abreu and Grimes are never specific) and there may even be a small percentage of Petit Verdot included in the blend. This is always the most floral of the Abreu wines, but it also has what the French call je ne sais quoi, a quality that is hard to pin down. The 2013 defines what Thorevilos is all about, with copious quantities of blueberries, black raspberries, truffles, violets, crushed rock, forest floor notes and oodles of glycerin in its full-bodied, incredibly pure and amazing texture and length. It is a spectacular wine, with the cascade of fruit hiding what must be some considerable tannic clout. It's not showing through just yet, but I suspect it will come as the wine closes down in bottle once it gets into a cold cellar. This is simply other-worldly and a tribute to all things Napa, California, and in a way, America. Drink it over the next 50+ years."

" The 2005 Cabernet Sauvignon Madrona Ranch is an extraordinary wine that has a European structural profile imposed on the incredibly rich, pure fruit of Napa. Incense, creme de cassis, licorice, toasty oak, and spring flowers are all present in the complex aromatics. In the mouth, the wine is full-bodied, very rich in extract and depth of concentration, but there is a

" Abreu is now calling his vineyard on Howell Mountain (a tract of 33 acres with 15 planted) Las Posadas, after the road high on the mountain that seems to be the Fifth Avenue of Howell Mountain vineyard sites. The 2013 Las Posadas Proprietary Red was unreal from barrel, and that extraordinary Midas touch exhibited by Grimes and Abreu has extended to this wine out of bottle, which is a showcase for Howell Mountain and the meticulous viticulture and winemaking of Abreu and Grimes. Inky purple to the rim, with an extraordinary nose of sweet mulberry, intense graphite, scorched earth, smoldering wood charcoal, and massive blackberry and cassis fruit, this intriguing and provocative wine also throws in hints of licorice and black truffle. It is extremely rich, full-bodied, and nearly an out-of-body experience. Look for it to improve in age for 40 to 50 years. I can see consumers opening it circa 2065 to 2075 and saying, "Wow – what a great vintage this must have been!"
