



The late Serge Hochar of Lebanon's premier, world-renowned winery Chateau Musar, has his own unique way to interpret older fine wines. **"When you taste a young wine it's like a baby and it talks to you like a baby. When you taste a mature wine it's like a man and it speaks to you like a man. I like my wines to age as they speak to you at different levels at different times."**

If you share a romanticist view about wines like we at WineWorld do, you will probably agree that a sip of a fully mature wine entails more than just a complex multi-sensory experience. You get to pry into the evolution of winemaking style of a winery and the region at large; and with a bit of imagination, travel back in time.

If a taste of history is your thing, do not miss out our older Musar selection ([We only have 1 bottle each of the 1956, 1959, 1960 and 1961!](#)) **1956 Musar** was made by Serge's father Gaston Hochar, founder of Chateau Musar, and bottled by his own, Serge Hochar in 1959. **1959 Musar** would mean most to Serge Hochar himself as that would be the first vintage when this then-civil engineering graduate took on the entire winery on the condition that his father let him do whatever he wanted.

Nearly 50 vintages latter, Serge Hochar has cemented Chateau Musar's status as not only the finest Lebanese wines, but also one that matches the ageing potential and quality of fine wine counterparts from rest of the world.

Reviews of older Musar reds are scant - after all, pre-1970s bottles were mostly all consumed by the Lebanese home market. We found you a note written by the well-respected wine critic Andrew Jefford on **1961 Musar red**:

"A typical old Musar: fragrant as Zanzibar, soft as feathers, succulent and melting as caramel. The fragrance (bolstered by record levels of VA, just like Cheval Blanc `47) suggests, after 30 years in bottle, wild mushrooms and the forest floor; the flavour is sweet, spreading and singing, the red fruits of the first sip metamorphosing towards date and fig. A purr of tannins still mark the wine's borders." (Tasted 3.4.93)

What is Musar Hochar Pere et Fils?

Musar Hochar Pere et Fils has often been conveniently described as the "second wine" of Chateau Musar. It is not quite so as Hochar Pere et Fils is actually made in distinctively different style. Whilst the Grand Vin Chateau Musar is made with Cabernet Sauvignon, Carignan and Cinsault from a selection of vineyards in the Bekaa Valley; **Hochar Pere et Fils is a single vineyard expression boasting a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Cinsault and Grenache.** The former spent a full seven years after the harvest; and the latter a full four years before they are released to the market.
